Student Artists may request one of the following free space size areas to display original pieces:

4'x8' foot space 8'x8' foot space

Attach to this application photos of all pieces to be considered for display. All artwork is subject to approval by the Department of Recreation & Culture. Artwork must be ready to hang and artists must provide hanging hooks and supplies. Some adult-themed pieces may not be approved.

This invitation is for display purposes only. Student Artists may not sell work. If you are a Professional/Above Novice Artist and interested in selling your works, use the Professional Artist Application (fees apply).

Student Artists may sit in chairs provided by City near artwork display. Ice chests, coolers, food items, and personal belongings may not be stored in front of art display.

Section A: Space Assignment

Student Artists shall not assign or transfer this Agreement nor the space nor any other rights under this Agreement. Student Artists may not switch spaces without prior authorization from event supervisor.

Distribution of flyers/literature must be done within the perimeters of the Student Artist space. Student Artist may not distribute or solicit outside display space.

Section B: Student Artist Display Area

Student Artist tent will contain assigned wall panels. Student Artists will be assigned panel(s) and a chair. Student Artist will need to supply hanging hooks, banner if desired, signage and personnel to assist as needed. Student Artist has complete responsibility for the staffing and operation of their display space.

Power is not available. Student Artist should be prepared to use battery-operated equipment.

The event will go on despite rain, wind or other inclement weather. Student Artists must be prepared to participate and occupy their display space(s) allocated to them regardless of weather conditions. Student Artist display, equipment and materials must be set up to withstand inclement weather and to ensure that it does not become a hazard to other vendors or the public.

Section C: Artisan Information Packet

Upon acceptance into the event, Student Artist will be notified by phone and given packet pick-up instructions. Student Artist Packets will include the following: general information sheet, directions to the venue, venue parking information, two Student Artist badges, one parking pass.

Section D: Student Artist Set Up and Tear Down

Upon arrival to the Artist Loading/Unloading area of the Palmdale Amphitheater, the City will provide, on a first-come, first-served basis, staff and handcarts to assist with transportation of Student Artist supplies and equipment. Student Artist is responsible for setting up and tearing down display. At the conclusion of the event, City staff assistance with transportation of supplies and equipment will take longer due to everyone vacating at the same time. It is recommended that you bring a handcart if possible. Student Artist shall completely remove the display and all materials brought on site by leaving their area clean and free of debris and rubbish.

Student Artist set up must be concluded by 9 am on event day. Overnight security will be provided Friday, October 13, 2017. Student Artist set up may be conducted on Friday, October 13, 2017 from 3-7 pm and/or Saturday, October 14 from 6-9 am.

Vehicles are not permitted on the grounds. Student Artists may not begin to tear down display until the grounds are clear of patrons. Tear down can begin at 6 pm and must be concluded by 9 pm on event day.

The City of Palmdale does not provide insurance of any kind for Student Artist's equipment or property. Student Artists are advised to have their property and equipment adequately insured.

Kaleidoscope is an outdoor event, subject to, among other potential risks, rain, high winds, theft, vandalism and the like. Student Artist is advised, in addition to carrying the required insurance, to govern themselves accordingly and take all appropriate precautions to safeguard their property and equipment and the property and persons of fellow vendors and visitors to the event.

Waiver: I, the undersigned, am fully aware and understand the potential risks involved with my participation in this cultural activity for the citizens of the City of Palmdale, namely the Kaleidoscope event. Specific dangers include damage to personal property, loss of personal inventory, serious physical injury or death. Additional dangers include and are not limited to damages due to inclement weather and other reasonably anticipated risks that accompany participation in such event. I acknowledge that I voluntarily participate in the event. I hereby agree to assume all risk of injury, damage to persons and property and/or death, and to hold the City of Palmdale, Department of Recreation and Culture and its officers, agents or employees harmless from any liability for any injuries, or claim for damage, damage to goods or death that may arise in connection with my participation in this event. This Hold Harmless Agreement also pertains to any actions of negligence by the City of Palmdale, Department of Recreation and Culture and its officers, agents, or employees which may have caused or contributed to the injury, damage, or death. This Agreement shall be binding upon my heirs and dependents as well as myself. I participate freely and voluntarily in this event and expressly assume all of the risks of the event.

Indemnification: Student Artist agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the City, its officers, agents and employees, from and against all claims, losses, obligations, or liability which arise out of, or are in any way related to, Student Artist's participation in the City's Kaleidoscope event and the display space(s) and display installed and operated by Student Artist and Student Artist's acts, errors or omissions, or those of its employees or agents under the Agreement.

Section E: Cancellation/Failure to Occupy Space

Student Artist may cancel this Agreement and the display space(s) allocated to them by written notice to City on or before September 21, 2017. Such termination by Student Artist terminates the Agreement.

Section F: Duties of the City

The City will provide and distribute media information and publicity.

The City is not responsible for any damage or theft of any goods, items or vendor display.

The City shall have employees at the event site from 6 am to 9 pm the day of the event.
