NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Palmdale on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, for the following Officers:

For Mayor to be  
Elected Citywide

Full term of Two (2) Years

For Two (2) Members  
of City Council  
from District One (1)  
and District Two (2)

Full Term of Four (4) Years

For Two (2) Members  
of City Council  
from District Three (3)  
and District Four (4)

Full Term of Two (2) Years

Council District One (1) is generally located in the southern portion of the City; Council District Two (2) is generally located in the western portion of the City; Council District Three (3) is generally located in the central portion of the City; and District Four (4) is generally located in the eastern portion of the City. The nomination period for these offices begins on Monday, July 18, 2016 and closes on Friday, August 12, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the City are not filed by August 12, 2016, (the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election) the voters shall have until the 83<sup>rd</sup> day before the election, August 17, 2016, to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88<sup>th</sup> day before the election, for that incumbent's elective office. This extension is not applicable where there is no incumbent eligible to be elected.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by §10229, Elections Code of the State of California.

The polls will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
