PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale’s popular Thursday Night on the Square (TNOTS) continues with the second of eight free events this Thursday, July 2, from 5:30 to 8:30 pm at Poncitlán Square (9th St. East between Ave. Q-9 & Ave. Q-10).

An Antelope Valley institution that is celebrating its 15th season, families can enjoy TNOTS’ live music, enticing food, free City activities for kids and an open-air market featuring specialty items.

“This week, our theme is ‘Heavy Metal Madness,’” said Recreation Supervisor Annie Pagliaro. “Kids will have fun ‘going mad’ on the Square by creating ribbon soda can tab bracelets, handmade foil art, and personalized stamped metal necklaces.”

Music will be provided by R&B favorites The Ambassadors of Soul.
