Palmdale City Library to Host “How to Get Around in the AV Via AVTA” Seminar

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library, in partnership with the Antelope Valley Transit Authority (AVTA) will host a class on “Travel Training” at the Library, 700 E. Palmdale Blvd., this Wednesday, October 15 from 11:30 am to 1 pm.

Patrons will learn how to increase their mobility through the Antelope Valley by learning how to identify the right buses and stops, about the fare system, and will receive personalized training with transit professionals in this free information session.

“The Travel Training program provides information and hands-on experience to Antelope Valley residents in an effort to improve their overall mobility,” said Palmdale Library Director Thomas Vose. “These sessions include educational seminars as well as trial rides with an instructor to walk individuals through the transit-riding experience.
