Action-Packed BMX Demonstration Coming to Palmdale City Library

John Parker, an author and BMX stunt rider, will demonstrate the amazing tricks he can perform to kids of all ages. This event is free, and no registration is required.

“Come check out an awesome show and ‘Read for the Win’ in our Summer Reading Program,” said Library Director Thomas Vose.

Parker is an author, BMX expert and director and spokesman for StuntMasters and the BMX Impact. Having discovered BMX freestyle by chance, he quickly fell in love with the sport and passion it inspired inside of him. After high school, Parker set his sights on making BMX his life and left his home town of Paso Robles to tour the world. He went on to compete in over a decade of X Games competitions, winning two MTV Sports and Music Festivals, multiple ASA Tour events, and earning a gold at the NBC Gravity Games along the way. Touring with Tony Hawk, performing at venues such as Universal Studios, the Olympic Ceremonies and hundreds of others he learned the power of inspiring others.
