Palmdale to Host “Beginning Guitar for Baby Boomers” Course

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale is offering a new “Beginning Guitar for Baby Boomers” class beginning in Feb. at the Palmdale Playhouse, 38334 10th St. East.

Taught by Vic Grady, classes will be held on consecutive Tuesdays from Feb. 3 through Feb 24, from 2:30 to 3:30 pm. The cost is \$60 with a \$10 material fee due to instructor at first class. Students will need to bring their own acoustic or electric guitar with a small amp.

No previous musical experience required. Students will learn the basic guitar chords and principles of rhythm to get started playing some of the most favorite Baby Boomer songs. Personal mentoring during the class time will help maximize growth on the instrument.

“This is a version of the beginning guitar course adapted for the generation that not only grew up listening to great rock ‘n’ roll, but who created the sound,” said Palmdale Recreation Coordinator Becky Bartlett.

The class will also be offered March 3 through 31, and April 7 through 28.
