Date Change for “Young Americans” at Palmdale City Library

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library, located at 700 E. Palmdale Blvd., will host the next meeting of “Young Americans,” a civics discussion group exclusively for teens ages 13 to 19, on Tuesday, Nov. 22 from 4 to 5 pm, instead of the previously scheduled date of Tuesday, Nov. 15.

“Young Americans” civics-based conversations address topics such as personal finance, the workings of the government, social media, and what it means to be an informed, active citizen. This month’s meeting, which takes place on November 15, will discuss the issues of crime, guns and police violence. Pizza will be available for participants as well.
