City of Palmdale Seeks Community Input at Complete Streets Open House

PALMDALE — The City of Palmdale will host a “Complete Streets” Open House on Tuesday, Dec. 6, 2016 from 6:30 to 8:30pm at the Chimbole Cultural Center, Manzanita Ballroom, located at 38350 Sierra Highway in Palmdale.

“Complete Streets’ are defined as streets for everyone,” said Transportation/Special Projects Manager Mike Behen. “They are designed and operated to accommodate all ages and abilities, including pedestrians, bicyclists, motorists and public transportation.”

As part of the City’s Active Transportation Program, the City is hosting the Open House to provide the community with an introduction to “Complete Streets,” its benefits, and how it may address existing transportation challenges in Palmdale. Attendees will have the opportunity to participate in interactive exercises and provide their input on transportation issues, opportunities and potential solutions.

“We’re encouraging our community to bring us their thoughts, questions and ideas on how to improve our streets for everyone in the community,” Behen said.
