Palmdale City Library to Host Dia de los Ninos/Dia de los Libros Celebration

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library host an event celebrating the upcoming “Dia de los Ninos” on Monday, April 27 at 4 pm at the Library, located at 700 E. Palmdale Blvd.

Crafts, snacks and fun will be available for kids to enjoy at this free event.

“Día is a very special day for libraries,” said Library Director Thomas Vose. “We celebrate the books that make our kids the best they can be in school and in life, and invite you to celebrate with us.”

Children's Day/Book Day, also known as El día de los niños/El día de los libros (Día), is a celebration of children, families, and reading held annually on April 30. The celebration emphasizes the importance of literacy for children of all linguistic and cultural backgrounds. Día is an enhancement of Children’s Day, which began in 1925. Children’s Day was designated as a day to bring attention to the importance and well-being of children. In 1996, nationally acclaimed children’s book author Pat Mora proposed linking the celebration of childhood and children with literacy to found El día de los niños/El día de los libros.

The Palmdale City Library is open seven days a week. Hours of operation are Monday through Thursday from 10 am to 8 pm; Friday and Saturday from 10 am to 5 pm; and Sunday from 1 to 5 pm.
