Emergency Preparedness Presentation for Seniors Coming  
This Thursday to Legacy Commons in Palmdale

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale’s neighborhood services department will host an emergency preparedness presentation for seniors this Thursday, Sept. 15 at 10 am at Legacy Commons for Active Seniors, located at 930 E. Ave. Q-9 in Palmdale. The presentation is free and open to the public.

The presentation will offer how-to information and suggestions on how to be properly prepared for emergency situations.

“Imagine that you have no electricity, no gas and no water,” said crime prevention specialist Kery German. “Imagine that all the businesses are closed or have nothing left on their shelves. In a major disaster it may be several days before help arrives. Are you and your family prepared for such an incident?”

“With our city being so close to the San Andreas Fault line, and as we have seen with recent fires and floods, being prepared is very important for our residents,” German said.

“While each individual’s needs and personal situations are unique, everyone can take steps to prepare for an emergency,” added German. “And always remember, it’s never too early to prepare but it can be too late.”
