New Online Resource at the Palmdale City Library: eSequels.com

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library is proud to announce that a new online resource, eSequels, is available free for Palmdale City Library card holders.

Patrons may access eSequels through the “Library Resources and Services” section of the Palmdale City Library’s website, located at www.cityofpalmdale.org/library.

Like the book Sequels, first published by ALA in 1982 and now in its 4th edition, this database aims to include the best, most enduring and most popular novels in series that might appeal to today's adult readers. eSequels indexes U.S. and British series novels and European series that have been translated into English. eSequels does not cover children's books, short story collections or non-fiction, except anecdotally within an annotation.

“We’re glad to be able to make this resource available to the public!” said Library Director Thomas Vose. “All you need is a Library card which is available free of charge. If you don’t have yours yet, stop by and we’ll set you up.”

The Palmdale City Library is open seven days a week. Hours of operation are Monday through Thursday from 10 am to 8 pm; Friday and Saturday from 10 am to 5 pm; and Sunday from 1 to 5 pm.
