Bus Excursion to Global Village Festival This Saturday

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale is hosting a bus excursion to the Global Village Festival this Saturday, Sept. 26.

The bus will leave Palmdale Transportation Center, 39000 Clock Tower Plaza at 8:30 am and return at 7 pm. Tickets are discounted to \$20 for Palmdale residents, and \$25 for non-residents.

“Travel the world in a day at this annual Irvine festival,” says Palmdale’s Recreation Supervisor Paula Leszkiewicz. “The multicultural festival features international cuisine, live entertainment, a children’s village with crafts and activities, cultural exhibits and an international marketplace.”

The Pasadena ARTWalk highlights some of the best Southern California visual artists showcasing their work in painting, sculpture, watercolor, photography, mixed media, ceramics, jewelry, drawing and printmaking. Rise of the Jack O’Lanterns is a unique, all-age, Halloween extravaganza featuring more than 5,000 professionally carved Jack O’Lanterns by artists and sculptors in a stunning night-time display at Descanso Gardens.

Big Bear Village & Alpine Zoo – Oct. 24, 7:30 am – 7 pm. \$30 - Discounted to \$25 for Palmdale residents.

Explore The Village at Big Bear Lake where you'll find a combination of alpine-style architecture and modern amenities. From there, you'll travel to Big Bear Alpine Zoo, a rehabilitation facility offering injured, orphaned and imprinted wild animals a safe haven. Some of the zoo's inhabitants include black bears, eagles, foxes and mountain lions.

The Reagan Presidential Library presents *Football! The Exhibition*.
