Public Invited to Community Open Houses Focusing on Palmdale to Burbank Portion
of California High Speed Rail Project

PALMDALE – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (CHSRA) is inviting the public to attend a community open house on Tuesday, June 2 from 5 to 8 pm at the Chimbole Cultural Center, 38350 Sierra Highway in Palmdale.

The Open House will give the public the opportunity to hear and discuss up-to-date-information on the alternatives under consideration for the Palmdale to Burbank project section of California's high-speed rail program.

The Palmdale to Burbank Project Section proposes to connect the Antelope Valley to the San Fernando Valley by traveling from the Palmdale Transportation Center to the Burbank Airport Station.

The CHSRA has been working with residents, stakeholders and regulatory agencies to refine the alignment alternatives for the project section.

There will also be a Community Open House on Saturday, June 6 from 9:30 to 12:30 pm in Acton at the High Desert School, 3620 Antelope Woods Road.
