Friday Is Deadline to Submit Written Comments Regarding Serial Rapist Christopher  
Hubbart's Housing Location in the Antelope Valley

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale is reminding residents that they have until this Friday, May 16 to submit written comments in regards to the proposed housing location for convicted serial rapist Christopher Hubbart at 20315 East Avenue R in unincorporated Los Angeles County, near Lake Los Angeles.

“We are encouraging anyone who has an interest in this matter to submit their written comments to the Los Angeles District Attorney's Office by this Friday,” said Assistant City Attorney Noel Doran. “They will compile the comments and present them to Santa Clara County Superior Court Judge Gilbert Brown at or before the May 21<sup>st</sup> hearing.”
