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AV Breweries to Bring the “Art of Brew” to Kaleidoscope Art & Music Festival

PALMDALE – Four Antelope Valley breweries will be part of the “Art of Brew” at the City of Palmdale’s brand new art and music festival called *Kaleidoscope* coming to the Palmdale Amphitheater on Saturday, Oct. 8 from 10 am to 6 pm. Admission and parking are free.

Transplants Brewing Company, Lucky Luke’s Brewing Company, Bravery Brewing and Kinetic Brewing Company will host beer tasting and conversation from 12 noon to 5 pm. Tickets will be available for purchase by individuals 21 years and older with ID.

“Craft brewing is an art form in and of itself,” said Palmdale’s Recreation Supervisor Annie Pagliaro. “The way these brewers approach making beer is admirable. They are artisans in their field and they will be talking to people about the intricacies of craft beer and the hobby of home brewing. What a great way for craft beer lovers to spend a Saturday afternoon!”

Transplants Brewing Company, located at 40242 La Quinta Lane, #101, Palmdale , focuses on hoppy west coast ales and creative specialties. They strive to brew inventive and flavorful creations and are always brainstorming new ideas and approaches for their beer. Just as Los Angeles attracts random people from all over the

world (their team originally hails from Chicago, New York and Arkansas), their specialty beer recipes draw from diverse, worldly and ethnic influences which often blur the lines between culinary and brewing sensibilities. In both senses, Transplants Brewing Company truly is “Ales for the Unrooted.” Transplants will be serving Filbert, a Brown ale with hazelnut and chocolate (6.5% abv), and Trance Plants, and IPA with Columbus and Chinook hops (7.1% abv).

Lucky Luke Brewing Company, located at 610 West Ave O, #104 in Palmdale, came to life simply from the love of craft beer. The original vision was to make the brewery a tribute to the founder’s great-grandfather, Luke Hammons. Luke was a lover of all things craft and American made. He was a family man and patriarch, who enjoyed working with his hands and could build just about anything. Lucky Luke will proudly serve Cartographer, a rye pale ale (5.5% abv) and Impresario, an IPA (7.5% abv).

Bravery Brewery, 42705 8th Street West in Lancaster, offers up to 30 varieties of amazing beer in our tasting room, as well as bottles, crowlers, growlers and kegs. Founded in 2011, they focus on recipe formulation, experimenting with brewing techniques and exploring exciting ingredients. Their catalog of beers varies widely from the highly traditional to the unique and unusual. Bravery will serve Allegiance IPA (6.9% abv) and Buster’s Brown Ale (6.0% abv).

Kinetic Brewing, located at 735 West Lancaster Blvd., was the first craft brewer to open in the Antelope Valley. The full-service restaurant and microbrewery features international pub cuisine for lunch and dinner, as well as American craft beer from Southern California and beyond. Kinetic will bring two of their most sought after beers of the year: Citrafuge, an XPA (extra pale ale) beer (5.5%) abv made with 100% fresh

Citra hops, and Afterburner, a 9.5% abv Hunormous IPA as it falls squarely between the accepted guidelines of what is a Double IPA and what is a Triple IPA.

Kaleidoscope: Art & Music fest will also feature stages of live music and visual and performing arts, artisan vendors and wares, food and educational.

At the heart of Kaleidoscope will be the talented artisans who will present their original works of art in various mediums for the public to learn, enjoy and appreciate art and culture. It will also be an opportunity for the public to purchase one-of-a-kind pieces.

Scheduled musical performers include The Sunday Night Singers, Paddy's Pig, Phat Cat Swinger, The High D Boys and the L.A. Cast of Beatlemania.

Food will be available for purchase and will be provided by Vince's Pasta & Pizza, Alex's Fruits & Nuts, Couple Nuts (kettlecorn and funnel cakes), Zodiac Grill, and From Me to you Catering, specializing in BBQ meat and turkey legs.

"With a wide variety of music, artisans, performers, food and craft beer, there is something for everyone at Kaleidoscope," Pagliaro said. "Free parking and free admission make this an affordable and fun day."
