PALMDALE - The City of Palmdale is accepting applications for one term on the Board of Library Trustees for a position that will expire in June of 2017.

The Board of Library Trustees is a group overseeing the Palmdale City Library that sets policies, helps with future planning and goal-setting, and acts as a liaison with groups such as the Friends of the Library, the City of Palmdale and others. The Board also helps advocate for the Library with elected officials and community stakeholders.

If appointed, a completed state mandated Statement of Economic Interests would be required.
