Informational Meeting for Palmdale Lifeguard Academy Slated for February 11

PALMDALE - The City of Palmdale's recreation & culture department will hold an informational meeting on Wednesday, Feb. 11 at 6 pm at Marie Kerr Pool 2723 Rancho Vista Blvd. for persons interested in learning more about the City's Lifeguard Academy. Space is limited.

The Lifeguard Academy will begin on Friday, Feb. 20 at Marie Park Pool and run until Sunday, March 8. It is designed to train individuals with emergency and lifesaving skills. Sessions will be held on Friday evenings from 6 to 9 pm, and all day Saturdays and Sundays during scheduled dates.

Seasonal lifeguard applicants must be at least 17 years old by May 1, 2015 and be able to swim at least 300 yards continuously. Participants who successfully complete requirements will receive certification necessary to apply for a summer job at the City's three swimming pools and at DryTown Water Park.

The cost is \$80 for residents and \$96 for non-residents.

The fee does not include supplies or certification fee. Certification fee of \$35 will need to be paid by Sunday, Feb. 15. More information will be given after the participant successfully completes the required swim test.
