Summer Activities Heating up at Palmdale's Domenic Massari Park

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale is bringing more free fun to residents at one of its most popular and visited parks.

Recreation and Culture Department Program Leaders will be on site at Domenic Massari Park, located at 37716 55th St. East, beginning June 6, Monday through Friday from 4 to 8 pm, and Saturday and Sunday from 10 am to 6 pm, leading a variety of basic free recreational activities for youth.

“We’re thrilled to have our Program Leaders onsite to Domenic Massari Park this summer to engage our residents,” said Palmdale’s Director of Recreation and Culture Keri Smith.

In addition, the Antelope Valley Boys and Girls Club members will be providing various free activities for kids and sharing information about club membership on Saturdays from 12 noon to 5 pm.

Palmdale’s Program Leaders will also be spreading the word about the City’s Park Watch program and encourage park users to take an active role in both using the park to its fullest and reporting any concerning behavior.

“Our staff will be a point of contact for park users, public safety officers and sheriff deputies,” said Smith. “To create the best experiences, it requires a partnership with park users and representatives of the City.”

“We’re also looking to see if people would like volunteer to share a skill or area of interest with others and be a part of our Park Ambassador program,” Smith added. “Some examples include tennis, a walking club or yoga in the park, which would be offered free of charge.”

Persons interested in volunteering for the Park Ambassador program should stop by the Domenic Massari office between the hours of 4 to 8 pm Monday through Friday, or between 10 am and 6 pm on Saturday and Sunday, and leave their contact information.

The City is also hosting its next Domenic Massari Park Watch meeting on June 28 at 7 pm at the basketball courts. All are welcome to attend.

Then on July 28, Palmdale will hold its annual National Night Out at Domenic Massari Park from 5 to 8 pm. Details will be announced soon.
