### PATH Homeless Assistance Available at Palmdale City Library

PALMDALE – Representatives from PATH (People Assisting the Homeless) will be at the Palmdale City Library, located at 700 E. Palmdale Blvd. on Monday, January 9 from 10 am to noon to provide free referrals services to agencies in the Antelope Valley that can assist with a variety of homeless-related issues.

PATH is a family of agencies working together to end homelessness for individuals, families, and communities. They strive to do this by prioritizing housing while providing customized supportive services for people in need. Their agencies each address homelessness in a different way—supportive services, permanent housing development, support for homeless families, and community engagement—all of which ultimately help the people they serve make it home.

PATH representatives will also be on site at the Library on Jan. 23, Feb. 6 and Feb. 27 from 10 am to 12 noon.
