PATH Representative Coming to Palmdale City Library

PALMDALE – A representative from PATH (People Assisting the Homeless) will be at the Palmdale City Library, located at 700 E. Palmdale Blvd. on Monday, June 20 from 10 am to noon to provide free referrals and support to homeless individuals.

PATH is a family of agencies working together to end homelessness for individuals, families, and communities. They strive to do this by prioritizing housing while providing customized supportive services for people in need. Their agencies each address homelessness in a different way—supportive services, permanent housing development, support for homeless families, and community engagement—all of which ultimately help the people they serve make it home.

A PATH representative will be on site at the Library every other Monday from 10 am to 12 noon.
