National Night Out to Be Rescheduled Due to Sand Fire

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale’s Neighborhood Services Department is rescheduling its annual National Night Out event, originally slated for this Thursday, July 28 from 5 to 8 pm at Domenic Massari Park, located at 37716 55th St. East in Palmdale.

“Due to the poor air quality as well as the limited public safety resources that are currently available due to the Sand Fire, the event will be rescheduled in August,” said Community Safety Supervisor Kelly Long. “We’ll announce the new date shortly.”

This year’s National Night Out festivities will be held on the west side of Domenic Massari Park, near the skate park. In addition to the many public safety displays from the Los Angeles County Sheriff’s and Fire Departments, residents will be treated to live music, a rock climbing wall, relay races and an opportunity to test their strength with the Bearcat Pull and a Dunk A Cop Tank. Raffle prizes will be given away courtesy of Target.

Ice cream and snacks will be available for purchase.

National Night Out is a nationwide crime and drug prevention awareness campaign designed to generate support for and participation in local anti-crime efforts. It strengthens neighborhood spirit and law enforcement-community partnerships and sends a message to criminals that neighborhoods are organized and fighting crime.
