### Public Invited to Attend Park Watch Meeting in Palmdale

PALMDALE – The City Of Palmdale’s crime prevention staff and Los Angeles County Sheriff’s Deputies will host a Park Watch meeting on Wednesday, June 29 at 7 pm on the basketball courts at Domenic Massari Park, located at 37716 55<sup>th</sup> Street East in Palmdale.
