Palmdale City Library to Host Puppet Show to Teach Emergency Preparedness

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library will host a “Preparedness Kids Puppet Show” on Saturday, May 17 at 11 am the Library, located at 700 E. Palmdale Blvd.

Presented in conjunction with The Los Angeles Region of the American Red Cross, kids will learn about earthquake and fire safety through three creative puppet shows.

“This is a non-threatening way for our children to learn the basics about being prepared for an emergency,” said Library Director Thomas Vose. “As parents, we don’t want to scare our children, yet at the same time we want them to know what to do in case something happens. Through the familiar puppet characters, kids will learn how find an earthquake ‘safety spot,’ how to crawl low in smoke and how to stop, drop and roll.”

The Palmdale City Library is open seven days a week. Hours of operation are Monday through Thursday from 10 am to 8 pm; Friday and Saturday from 10 am to 5 pm; and Sunday from 1 to 5 pm.
