City of Palmdale to Begin Rancho Vista Overlay
from 30th St. West to Ave. N-8 on Sept. 19

PALMDALE — The City of Palmdale will begin a road resurfacing project on Rancho Vista Blvd. from 30th St. West to Ave. N-8 on Thursday, Sept. 19.

The \$1.5 million project was awarded to Hardee & Harper at the June City Council Meeting. The project will resurface 1,162,000 square feet of pavement, roughly four percent of the arterial network.

The work will be done from 8 am to 5 pm and is expected to end on Friday, Oct. 13.

“This method of pavement preservation will ensure the streets will maintain performance and utilize the existing pavement asset an additional 20 years before the area will need to be revisited,” said Palmdale Public Works Director Mike Mischel.

The project is funded by a \$1.4 million street resurfacing federal grant and an addition \$160,000 from the street resurfacing grant AB 2925.

“The City of Palmdale has 504 miles of roads, totaling over 91.8 million square feet of asphalt,” noted Mischel. “Regular maintenance of roads is an important part of the City’s ongoing Capital Improvement Projects.”
