Second Annual AV “Brass Butt” Charity Ride for SAVES Set for October 19

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale’s South Antelope Valley Emergency Services (SAVES) food and shelter program will host the second annual “Brass Butt” Charity Motorcycle Ride on Sunday, Oct. 19 at 8:30 am to help raise funds to provide emergency assistance to families in need in the South Antelope Valley.

The ride will begin and end at SAVES, located at 1002 E. Ave. Q-12, and proceed 169 miles through scenic parts of the Antelope Valley and Tehachapi.

Registration is \$25 per rider and \$20 per passenger in advance now through Oct. 15 and available online at www.cityofpalmdale.org. Day of registration will be held from 8 to 9 am at SAVES and will be \$30 per rider and \$25 per passenger. Registration includes the scenic ride, a catered lunch by Dickey’s Barbecue Pit, live radio remote broadcast, and one free opportunity ticket for cash prizes. Prizes include one grand prize for \$300, 4 - \$100 cash prizes, and 4-\$50 cash prizes.

“Even if you don’t ride motorcycles, you’re invited to participate by riding along in your car,” Morales said.
