“Season of Service” Community Service Project on Tap This Saturday in Palmdale

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale’s “2015 Season of Service” program will host a community service work day this Saturday, Feb. 21 from 8 am to noon at 1020 East Ave. Q-5, between 10th St. East and 10th Place East, near the City’s newest Neighborhood House #5 and Community Garden.

Registration will begin at 8 am. Service activities start at 9 am and will include working on the community garden in preparation for spring planting, graffiti removal, debris clean up, door to door outreach regarding the future mission and activities planned for the soon-to-be completed Neighborhood House, and recruitment for potential candidates for the construction training program which will soon begin in the City’s 3rd and 4th Focus Neighborhoods.

Live music and special activities for the kids will also be a part of the event. A free BBQ lunch will be provided to all participants at 12 noon.

Funding for the event has been provided through a generous \$5,000 grant from Southern California Edison. Some of the community partners who are collaborating with the project include Antelope Valley Youth Build, Advancing Communities Together, Word of Life Outreach Ministries, Victory Outreach and Green Thumb Nursery.

“Please mark your calendars for Saturday, Feb. 21 and come out and enjoy a great time with all of our community partners in remembrance of the spirit of Dr. King,” said Palmdale’s Director of Neighborhood Services Mike Miller. “Let’s make a difference in our community and invite others to do the same.”
