“Stamp Out Hunger” is
City of Palmdale’s Final “Season of Service” Project for 2016

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale’s 2016 “Season of Service” wraps up on Saturday, May 14 with an “Stamp Out Hunger” project to be held at South Antelope Valley Emergency Services (SAVES) 1002 East Avenue Q-12, Palmdale, in partnership with the National Association of Letter Carriers 24th annual *Stamp Out Hunger* Food Drive.

Registration will take place at the 3:30 pm at SAVES. The project will run from 4 to 7 pm. An adult must accompany volunteers under the age of 16. All participants must complete a release of liability available at event registration. Close-toed, rubber soled shoes are recommended. Weather appropriate clothing as some of the work will take place outside. Water will be provided. Verification of service hours available.

The annual Stamp Out Hunger food drive—the nation’s largest one-day drive—provides letter carriers, other postal employees and thousands of volunteers across the nation the opportunity to meld their forces together to conduct the drive in communities across America. The goal is to help restock community food banks, pantries and shelters for needy families throughout the summer, and to build upon the 1 billion pounds of non-perishable food collected since 1992 from millions of generous postal customers. The drive is held each year on the second Saturday in May.
