Fifth Harmony to Perform at Palmdale Amphitheater July 19

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale has added the popular all girls group Fifth Harmony to the summer concert series on July 19, replacing Zendaya, who has cancelled her summer concert dates due to a scheduling conflict.

Tickets for Fifth Harmony are on sale at www.cityofpalmdale.org/TheAmp. In addition, previously purchased Zendaya tickets will be honored at the Fifth Harmony concert. Ticket holders who purchased Zendaya tickets online will be contacted by email.

Fifth Harmony formed during the second season of *The X Factor*. With their show-stopping vocals, undeniable charisma, and genuine sisterly bond, the “fearsome fivesome” (as they became known), endeared themselves to viewers across the country.

“I can feel a wave beginning behind this group, said *The X Factor* creator and judge Simon Cowell. “The chemistry between the Fifth Harmony girls both on and offstage is fantastic. They’re fun to be around and most importantly, they are all incredibly talented.”

In the short time since, they have won numerous awards including Radio Disney Music Award for 2014 Breakout Artist of the Year, Shorty Awards for Best Band in Social Media, and *Billboard’s* Girl Group Week Most Promising New Girl Group. They

were handpicked to be part of Disney's "Next Big Thing" campaign, MTV and Pop Tarts "Crazy Good VMA Concert," and won the fan-voted Vevo's Lift Artist Award.

Fifth Harmony's debut EP *Better Together*, released October 22, 2013, skyrocketed to #2 on iTunes and now officially lands the group their first Top Ten Album, which debuted at #6 on the Billboard Top 200 Chart. Featuring five brand new songs and their smash hit "Miss Movin' On," it's a diverse, dynamic, and delightful introduction to America's only teen pop female vocal groups. The girls just announced that their first single off their EP is "Don't Want to Dance Alone," an upbeat party tune that will make everyone want to get onto the dance floor.

Fifth Harmony released four other EP editions in 2014: Their Spanish EP, *Junto* and *Juntos Acoustic* (November 11), *Better Together Acoustic* (November 19) and *Better Together Remixes* (November 25).

The group's members are Ally Brooke Hernandez, Normani Hamilton, Dinah Jane Hansen, Camila Cabello, and Lauren Jauregui. Cumulatively, they have 70 million YouTube views, 625,000-plus Facebook "likes," and over one million Twitter followers.

Other headliners in Palmdale's summer concert series include country star **Phil Vassar** on Saturday, July 12, R&B legends **The Whispers** on July 26, and **Banda Machos** on August 2.

Phil Vassar's career has seen the release of eight albums, two ASCAP Songwriter of the Year trophies, *Billboard* Country Songwriter of the Year, countless hits as a singer and songwriter, a mantle full of awards, and the launch of his own Rodeowave Entertainment label. He has hit the Top 5 seven times with songs like "Carlene," "Last Day of My Life" and "American Child," and topped the charts with "In A

Real Love” and the perennial favorite “Just Another Day in Paradise.” Known as one of Nashville’s top tunesmiths, his songs other artists have taken to #1 include “My Next Thirty Years” by Tim McGraw, “She’s Right On The Money” by Alan Jackson, and Jo Dee Messina’s “Bye, Bye” and “I’m Alright.” New artist David Nail had a hit with Phil’s “The Sound of a Million Dreams,” which *Billboard* named the #1 song in their Top 10 Country Songs of 2012.

The Whispers are one of only a few “old school” groups that can boast of having over 40 years in the industry with a worldwide fan base, maintaining their vocal dominance and original members. They have amassed four decades of pop and R&B hits including “Rock Steady,” “It’s a Love Thing,” “And the Beat Goes On”; seven gold albums, two platinum albums, 12 top twenty singles, 40 chart hits, and nominations from the American Music Awards, Soul Train Awards and Grammy Awards. The Whispers were inducted into the Vocal Group Hall of Fame in 2003.

Since their formation in 1990, **Banda Machos** (or “La Reina de las Bandas” as they’re commonly known) have been blazing a trail in the Mexican Regional market. Their unique blend of Banda, Quebradita and Ranchera sounds have led to #1 singles, platinum albums and countless awards from their musical peers. Now 22 years into their career, this 13-piece ensemble is going strong and kicking off the most exciting phase of their career as the creators of Quebradita with their techno banda style. On the social networks, **Banda Machos** are a dominant force as well. Their smash single “No Hay Problema” has earned nearly two million YouTube views and videos for “Sangre De Indio” and “Al Gato y El Raton” (their all-time biggest hit) are well into the millions.

General admission tickets for all four concerts can be purchased online at www.cityofpalmdale.org/TheAmp for \$10. A limited number of VIP tickets are available for Phil Vassar and Banda Machos at \$20, which includes express entry and seating at the front of the stage, ensuring that VIP ticket holders can arrive just before the concert and still get one of the best seats in the house. VIP seating is theater style (first-come, first-served).

Gates open at 6 pm and the concerts begin at 8 pm rain or shine. Guests are encouraged to bring lawn chairs or blankets. Carry-in food, beverages, coolers, alcohol and pets are not permitted. Food, beer and wine will be available for purchase.

About Palmdale Amphitheater ('The Amp')

The Amp at Marie Kerr Park is the Antelope Valley's premier outdoor entertainment venue, providing audiences with a blend of high energy concert performances and community-based programming. Its convenient location, great sight lines and comfortable, grassy seating areas are complemented by Saturday evening concerts and Friday evening Family Movie Nights presented during summer months.

For many years, the City of Palmdale hosted the Starlight Concert Series on a baseball field at Marie Kerr Park, and guests would come as early as 3 am to set out their blankets and stake their spots to watch entertainers perform on a portable stage. There were often smaller events held prior to the concerts, like Family Western Days, Taste of the Valley and the Fourth Saturday Cruise. Soon, however, the concerts were bursting at the seams with guests, and it became clear that a larger venue was needed.

In 2005, after Palmdale residents voted for a bond measure to provide funds for the construction, the Palmdale Amphitheater was opened at the newly expanded Marie Kerr Park site, ushering in a new era. The new amphitheater featured amenities that were not available at the old site, such as permanent restrooms, areas for food vendors, and even a "real" green room for the entertainers.
