#### Registration Open for Next Session of “Palmdale Works! Youth Job Academy”

PALMDALE – The City of Palmdale’s “Palmdale Works! Youth Job Academy,” designed for youths ages 15 through 18 who are interested in developing the skills needed to successfully interview for a job, is accepting registrations for its next session.

The Academy will be held Tuesdays and Thursdays from March 24 through April 9. Classes will be conducted from 3:30 to 5:30 pm at the Larry Chimbote Cultural Center, 38550 Sierra Highway in Palmdale.

During the course of the program, Academy students will be taught how to dress and prepare for a job interview, as well as meeting employers from local businesses and role-playing in mock interviews. Participants must attend each session to graduate.

"Participation in a program like this really does speak volumes to potential employers about the motivation and commitment of any young person entering the job market," said Palmdale’s Community Programs Supervisor Trish Jones.

The “Palmdale Works! Youth Job Academy” was created in 2008 to assist youths in preparing for the competitive job market.
