Veterans Day Holiday Closures for City of Palmdale

PALMDALE – City of Palmdale administrative and business offices, the Palmdale Playhouse, South Antelope Valley Emergency Services (SAVES), Legacy Commons for Active Seniors and the Palmdale City Library will be closed on Wednesday, Nov. 11 in observance of Veterans Day.

Administrative and business offices will reopen Thursday, Nov. 12 at 7:30 am. The Palmdale City Library will reopen on Thursday, Nov. 12 at 10 am. SAVES will reopen on Thursday, Nov. 12 at 9 am. Legacy Commons will reopen on Thursday, Nov. 12 at 8 am.

Customers may register for recreation and culture classes 24 hours a day, every day at www.cityofpalmdale.org/playpalmdale. Tickets for Palmdale Playhouse shows may be purchased 24 hours a day, every day at www.cityofpalmdale.org/playhouse. Library materials may be renewed, fines paid, and online services such as e-books, Homework Help, eLibrary and Mango Languages may be accessed 24 hours a day, every day at www.cityofpalmdale.org/library. Business Licenses may be renewed online 24 hours a day at <https://palmdale.onestoppayments.net/webrenewals/>.

In case of an emergency, residents may call 661/267-5338 to report issues such as sewer overflows, roadway/right of way hazards including downed tree limbs, downed signs and potholes, or broken sprinkler lines in City parks and landscaped areas.

Residents are invited to attend the annual Veterans Day service co-hosted by the Antelope Valley Service Organization (AVSOA) and the *AV Wall* organization on Wednesday, Nov. 11 at 11 am. Taking part in the ceremony will be emcee Bobby Breech of the AVSOA, Highland High School AFJROTC as Color Guard, The Sunday Night Singers and members of the Palmdale High School Chamber Singers performing the National Anthem, Bruce Robertson reciting the poem "Freedom's Wall," George Palermo presenting "What is Veterans Day," and a recognition of all veterans in attendance during a performance of the "Armed Forces Medley."
