Veterans Day Holiday Closures for City of Palmdale

PALMDALE – City of Palmdale administrative and business offices, the Palmdale Playhouse, South Antelope Valley Emergency Services (SAVES), Legacy Commons for Active Seniors, Chimbole Cultural Center and the Palmdale City Library will be closed on Friday, Nov. 11 in observance of Veterans Day.

The Joe Davies Heritage Airpark at Palmdale Plant 42 will be open Veterans Day. The Marie Kerr Park Recreation Center and Palmdale Oasis Park recreation center will be open for regularly schedule programs.

Administrative and business offices will reopen Monday, Nov. 14 at 7:30 am. The Palmdale City Library will reopen on Saturday, Nov. 12 at 10 am. SAVES will reopen on Monday, Nov. 14 at 9 am. Legacy Commons will reopen on Monday, Nov. 12 at 8 am.
