“Dead Man’s Footsteps” Is Next Up For Palmdale City Library’s Mystery Book Club

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library’s Mystery Book Discussion Group “Mystery, Murder and Mayhem” will discuss the book *Dead Man’s Footsteps* by Peter James on Wednesday, Jan. 21, at 7 pm, at the Larry Chimbole Cultural Center, 38350 Sierra Highway.
