March Violets is Subject of Palmdale City Library Mystery Book Club Discussion

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library’s Mystery Book Discussion Group “Mystery, Murder and Mayhem” will discuss the book *March Violets* by Philip Kerr this Wednesday, March 18 at 7 pm at the Chimbole Cultural Center, 38350 Sierra Highway.

Kerr is a Scottish author known for his hardboiled noir novels, especially the “Bernie Gunther” series, of which *March Violets* is the first title. In this book, Bernie Gunther, a German detective in 1930s Berlin, must solve crimes involving stolen treasures and missing Jews as the Nazis rise to power around him.

The Mystery, Murder and Mayhem Mystery Book Discussion Group meets the third Wednesday of the month at 7 pm, at the Chimbole Cultural Center. The group is open to anyone who enjoys a good mystery.
