Palmdale City Library's Mystery Book Club Breaks into a *Dead Run*

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library's Mystery Book Discussion Group "Mystery, Murder and Mayhem" will discuss the book *Dead Run* by P.J. Tracy on Wednesday, Jan. 20 at 7 pm at the Chimbole Cultural Center, located at 38350 Sierra Highway.

Computer game company founders Grace MacBride and Annie Belinsky—along with Wisconsin deputy Sharon Mueller—are en route to Green Bay, following reports of a serial killer, when their car breaks down deep in the northern woods. A short walk through the forest leads them to the eerily quiet town of Four Corners, where they find severed phone lines and a complete absence of any life. But the quiet is deceptive.
