Palmdale City Library Mystery Book Club to Discuss *Monkeewrench*

PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library’s Mystery Book Discussion Group “Mystery, Murder and Mayhem” will discuss the book *Monkeewrench* by P.J. Tracy on Wednesday, April 15, at 7 pm, at the Chimbole Cultural Center, 38350 Sierra Highway, in Palmdale.

People are dying for the new computer game by the software company Monkeewrench---literally. With “Serial Killer Detective” out in limited release, the real-life murders of a jogger and a young woman have already mimicked the first two scenarios in the game. But Grace McBride and her eccentric Monkeewrench partners are caught in a vise. If they tell the Minneapolis police of the link between their game and the murders, they'll shine a spotlight on the past they thought they had erased, and the horror they thought they'd left behind. If they don't, eighteen more people will die.

P.J. Tracy is the pseudonym of mother-daughter writing duo P.J. and Traci Lambrecht, winners of the Anthony, Barry, Gumshoe, and Minnesota Book Awards. Their novels, *Monkeewrench*, *Live Bait*, *Dead Run*, *Snow Blind*, and *Shoot to Thrill* are national and international bestsellers.

The Mystery, Murder and Mayhem Mystery Book Discussion Group meets the third Wednesday of the month at 7 pm, at the Larry Chimbole Cultural Center.
