Palmdale City Library Mystery Book Club to Discuss “Where Are You Now” This Wednesday  
PALMDALE – The Palmdale City Library’s Mystery Book Discussion Group “Mystery, Murder and Mayhem” will discuss the book *Where Are You Now* by Mary Higgins Clark this Wednesday, Dec. 17, at 7 pm, at the Larry Chimbole Cultural Center, 38350 Sierra Highway.

It has been ten years since twenty-one-year-old Charles MacKenzie Jr. (“Mack”) went missing. He walked out of his apartment on Manhattan’s Upper West Side without a word to his college roommates and has never been seen again. However, he does make one ritual phone call to his mother every year: on Mother’s Day. Each time, he assures her he is fine, refuses to answer her frantic questions, then hangs up. Mack’s sister, Carolyn, is now twenty-six, a law school graduate, and has just finished her clerkship for a civil court judge in Manhattan. She has endured two family tragedies, yet she realizes that she will never be able to have closure and get on with her life until she finds her brother.

Mary Higgins Clark's books are world-wide bestsellers. In the U.S. alone, her books have sold over 80 million copies. She is the author of twenty-four suspense novels.

The Mystery, Murder and Mayhem Mystery Book Discussion Group meets the third Wednesday of the month at 7 pm, at the Larry Chimbole Cultural Center.
