



## DryTown Water Park Policies

1. No Running and no diving.
2. No outside flotation devices are allowed. Inner tubes and life jackets are provided free of charge.
3. No coolers, outside food, drink, or tobacco is permitted in DryTown.
4. Individuals are permitted to carry one sealed bottle of water into the park. No bulk packs of water will be permitted.
5. Appropriate attire, behavior and language are required. Inappropriate behavior, language or vulgar attire unsuitable for a family environment will be grounds for refusing admission or removal from the park without a refund.
6. Dress Code: Traditional swimwear is required. No provocative or thong swimsuits. Street clothes, cut-offs, snaps, buttons, rivets, belts and metal ornamentation are not allowed. Please remember that this is a family-oriented facility. Dress appropriately.
7. Diapered guests must wear approved plastic swim diapers, which can be purchased at cost in DryTown's General Store. Disposable swim diapers (such as Little Swimmers) of any kind cannot be substituted for the plastic swim diapers.
8. Swim shoes are not permitted on any slide. However, guests are encouraged to wear them while walking the grounds of the park.
9. Guests must be at least **48 inches** tall to ride any of the large slides (Rattler's Revenge, Devil's Punch Bowl and The Wildcatter).
10. Guests must be at least **42 inches** tall to ride Big Rock River without adult supervision. Guests under 42 inches may use Big Rock River with adult supervision provided on a one-to-one ratio.
11. Guests must be at least **36 inches** tall to use Little Miner's Camp without adult supervision. Guests under 36 inches may use Little Miner's Camp with adult supervision provided on a one-to-one ratio.
12. DryTown is not responsible for lost or stolen item.
13. Some attractions will close during inclement weather. (Rain, lightning and thunderstorms or wind above 40 MPH)
14. For guest protection, use of recording devices (cameras/video cameras) and cell phone is strictly prohibited in restrooms and locker area.
15. Photographers are occasionally employed by the City to take photos for promotional purposes. Entrance grants consent for your photo to be used in promotional material.
16. Patrons are responsible for their own safety in the park. Rowdy behavior and excessive horseplay may lead to serious accidents and are prohibited.
17. Re-entry permitted with admission receipt or hand stamp.
18. Pregnant women & persons with heart conditions or back trouble should not use the slides or the river.

**To make the most of your visit, don't forget** sun block, a hat, sandals and a towel. These items, as well as souvenirs and, are also available for purchase at the DryTown General Store.
