

LETTER FROM THE CITY MANAGER

Dear Resident,

In our last issue of Palmdale: News, Activities and Entertainment, I wrote about the importance of keeping your shopping dollars in Palmdale. With the current economic situation brewing nationally and statewide, shopping locally is more important now than ever.

Simply put, sales tax dollars are the City's single largest source of revenue. These tax dollars provide funding for vital services such as sheriff and fire protection to quality-of-life activities such as our parks and recreation programs, the Palmdale Playhouse, Starlight Concerts and Thursday Night on the Square.

Ensuring a steady flow of revenue is vital to the continued success of our City. In 2009, Palmdale voters may have the opportunity to vote on a measure that will increase the transient occupancy tax (TOT) from 7 percent to 10 percent. The TOT is a tax on hotel and motel stays. Those who stay in our hotels will pay this tax. Money generated from the TOT will go into the general fund for services such as public safety and economic development.



The increase in TOT would put Palmdale on par or below the City of Los Angeles (14 percent), Long Beach (12 percent), Santa Monica (14 percent), Glendale (10 percent), Santa Clarita (10 percent) Burbank (10 percent) and Los Angeles County (12 percent).

In the meantime, we at the City of Palmdale are continuing to look at ways to reduce spending while providing the best possible service to our residents. We look forward to serving you in 2009 and beyond.

CRIME CONTINUES TO PLUMMET IN PALMDALE

The crime rate in the City of Palmdale continued to drop drastically in the first three quarters of 2008, with an overall Part I crime reduction of 11.3 percent in the first three quarters of the year.

Part I crimes are murder and non-negligent manslaughter, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny/theft, motor vehicle theft and arson.

"We're seeing the continued effectiveness of combining law enforcement with preventive action and community engagement in Palmdale," said Palmdale's Director of Public Safety and Community Relations Anne Ambrose.

"We began by implementing the Partners Against Crime program in 1992 and continued with the expanded mission of Partners for a Better Palmdale program in 2007 which is making Palmdale a safer community," said Ambrose.




Palmdale's Crime Prevention Officer Vicky Razo teams up with Palmdale Sheriff's Deputy Layne Arnold to serve Zone 3 in Palmdale. The City has paired up each of its crime prevention officers with Los Angeles County Sheriff's deputies who will serve as the 'town sheriff' for each of the four distinct zones in Palmdale. Staff and deputies collaborate to serve as the central point of contact with residents to address crime problems in their districts.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH GROUPS TOP 300

The number of Neighborhood Watch Groups in Palmdale has reached 306 and the number is growing. "That's a 371 percent increase since Partners for a Better Palmdale program began," said Community Safety Supervisor Kelly Long.

"Our Neighborhood Watch and Business Watch groups provide an easy and highly effective way to reduce and eliminate crime in our neighborhoods and businesses," said Long. To

BUSINESS OPENING BOOM CONTINUES

A bright spot in the economy has been the continued opening of several retail and commercial establishments in the City of Palmdale.

Leading the way of new openings were Claim Jumper Restaurant, Buffalo Wild Wings and Sonic Drive-In, all of which posted outstanding grand openings. Also new on the scene are Butler's Coffee, Play N Trade Video Games, La Casa Rustica, Happy Nails and Spa and Armed Forces Recruitment Center, all on 10th Street West near the Super Wal-Mart Center. Love Sushi, Fire Island Grill and Sam's Asian Kitchen are slated to open shortly.

On 5th Street West and Palmdale Boulevard, the new Challenger Business Park offers over 100,000 square feet of commercial/retail space near the soon-to-open Palmdale Regional Medical Center. Camille's Sidewalk Café recently opened in the Park. Super Target Center, PetSmart, Staples, Ross Dress For Less, Bath & Body Works, Famous Footwear and El Pollo Loco are now serving residents on the east side. Plans are in the works for a Vallarta Market at Avenue R and 47th Street East.

PALMDALE MEDICAL CENTER TO OPEN IN 2009


The much-anticipated opening of the Palmdale Regional Medical Center, located at Tierra Subida and Palmdale Boulevard, is scheduled for fall 2009. The 239-bed hospital will have the largest emergency room in the Antelope Valley with 35 beds.

Located next to the hospital is the first of two 60,000-square-foot medical office buildings for members of the local medical community who wish to have offices nearby. Also slated to open near the site is Summer Terrace Apartments, a senior housing project.

Free Online Test Prep Resource Available

The Palmdale City Library is offering a free online service called LearningExpress Library that is designed to help users overcome test-taking anxiety, raise test scores and improve test-taking skills.

"LearningExpress Library is an amazing resource for anyone preparing for career-oriented or academic tests," said Palmdale Reference Service Supervisor Diane Hanville. "It includes a broad range of practice tests based on official exams for careers such as firefighter, police officer, postal worker, cosmetologist, paramedic, real estate agent and the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB). It also has practice tests for advanced placement and entrance exams such as the ACT, SAT, GRE and LSAT as well as GED practice tests," said Hanville. "Tests are scored instantly with feedback included for help in improving scores."

In addition, tutorials are available to assist in creating resumes and improving interview techniques. There are also courses offered in math, reading and writing.

STRATEGIC PLAN FEATURED ON CITY'S WEB SITE

With the invaluable input of residents and stakeholders, the City of Palmdale has successfully completed a Strategic Plan that identifies long-term direction, short-term goals and specific action steps for the City.

"The Strategic Plan was the result of a highly participatory process that included input and feedback from approximately 575 residents, community stakeholders and employees," said Assistant to the City Manager Sayne Redifer.

The Strategic Plan identifies twelve strategic focus areas that the City will advance during the next five years. They include: youth, public safety, water, transportation, economic development/job creation, senior services/senior housing, quality of life, growth/sustainable development, community engagement/community outreach, recreation/parks/trails/open space, municipal finance consideration/fiscal responsibility, and high performance work environment.

Palmdale Power Plant *Charges Ahead*

The City of Palmdale's proposed 570-megawatt hybrid power plant is charging ahead to meet its expected 2012 completion date.

"Our application was submitted in August 2008, it was deemed 'data accurate' in October, and the California Energy Commission (CEC) held its first public hearing in Palmdale on December 4," said Palmdale City Manager Steve Williams.

"Our efforts are the culmination of several years of intense efforts to identify the best plant design and a location that is compatible with the City's future plans," said Williams. "We recognized the need for additional electricity generation to meet the increasing demand, and we believe the integration of solar thermal technology and combined cycle technology is the best fit for the City of

Palmdale and California."

The power plant, or hybrid plant as it is often called because of its large solar energy component, will be located along the south side of Avenue M east of Sierra Highway.

"One of the best attributes of this hybrid plant is that it has the ability to produce electricity whenever it is needed but can rely on the renewable energy when the electricity demand is at its highest, during the daylight hours," Williams said. "The demand for electricity has steadily increased since we first began investigating a power plant and this project will ensure an adequate and competitively priced supply of electricity for our residents and businesses."

Construction is expected to begin in early 2010 and is scheduled to take approximately 30 months. Commercial operation could begin as soon as the summer of 2012.

Online Registration

Visit www.cityofpalmdale.org and click on the registration link. Activities available for online registration are identified by a 'mouse' icon.

- **New customers** and those who have not registered within the past three years must visit the parks and recreation office to open an account. Proof of address (Calif. I.D. or utility bill) is required to verify Palmdale residency. An e-mail address must be provided to register online.

- **Returning customers who have not provided an e-mail address** must call parks and recreation to obtain a Family ID and Account PIN.

- **Returning customers who have provided an e-mail address** may obtain a Family ID and Account PIN by visiting www.playpalmdale.com.

Registration information

Some classes require on site registration. In most cases, students must be enrolled with payment prior to participation. Register online, at the parks and recreation office or Palmdale Oasis Park Center (POPC). You may register during operating hours in person, by fax or phone. Programs are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Information is subject to change.

Resident/non-resident information

Resident and non-resident fees are in place for the benefit of Palmdale residents. Those living outside Palmdale city limits pay an additional fee for some registrations.

Sibling discount

A discount rate is offered for select programs to register two or more children in your immediate family into the **same program**. Discount is not available online.

Proof of age requirement

Tiny Tots and Youth Sports programs require child's proof of age (birth certificate or immunization record; both required for Tiny Tots) at time of registration.

Payment options

Payment may be made by cash, check, Visa or MasterCard. Adult sports programs require payment by company check, cashier's check, money order or cash (personal checks accepted from team managers only). **Please make checks payable to City of Palmdale.** The City charges a \$25 fee for returned checks.

Withdrawal/refund policy

Full refunds/credits are available for courses cancelled by the City or instructor. Patron-requested cancellations must be received three days before the second meeting for full refund/credit. No refund/credit will be issued after this time. For cash or check transaction refunds, please allow four to six weeks to process.

Bus excursion cancellations must be made one week in advance to receive an account credit; refunds are not issued for this program. **Aquatics program** cancellations must be made seven days prior to the first meeting. Late requests will be processed as an account credit for 50% of the fee. Withdrawals/refunds are not available once the program begins.

Contract instructors

While many programs are supervised by staff, others are taught by contract instructors. If you are interested in teaching a class, visit www.cityofpalmdale.org/departments/parks and click on Contract Instructor Questionnaire.

Waiver

A signed Release, Waiver, and Assumption of Risk is required for all program participants.

Facility Fun Pass

Those using the Hammack Activity Center, Palmdale Oasis Park Recreation Center (POPC) and both skateparks must present a City-issued Facility Fun Pass photo ID card. It is accepted at all four sites, and is issued at POPC and the parks and recreation office. A parent or guardian must be present for children under age 18 to obtain a card. The first card is free; lost cards may be replaced for \$5.
