New Extended Saturday Hours at Waste Management's Palmdale Landfill

WM, formerly known as Waste Management, is pleased to announce Palmdale Landfill's NEW enhanced Saturday operating hours effective May 7, 2022.

The public can now visit Palmdale Landfill on Saturday's from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm, which will give Antelope Valley residents an additional two hours to bring unwanted materials for recycling and disposal on a Saturday.

The Palmdale Landfill is also home to the Antelope Valley Environmental Collection Center (AVECC) where residents can properly drop off household hazardous waste and electronic waste free of charge.

Acceptable household hazardous waste includes paint, oil, batteries, as well as old electronics such as TVs, monitors, computers, tablets, and printers.

No business or commercial waste is allowed.
