

# Little Miner's Camp and Slides



**By using this ride, you are voluntarily participating in a hazardous recreational activity and assume any and all risks associated with this ride.**

- Please look at the ride and decide for yourself if you can ride. You are the best judge of your limitations. Guests, whose physical or mental limitations could be a hazard for themselves or others, should not ride.
- Failure to follow all rules and instructions can result in serious injury to yourself and others.
- Riders must sit or lie on their back, feet first at all times. Do not rock, stop, slow, run, dive, stand, kneel, or rotate in the slide. Do not dive in the pool.
- Guests under 36 inches (.91 m) tall are not permitted on a slide without adult supervision.
- Maximum rider weight is 250 lbs. (113 kg) per slide.
- Guests with the following conditions should not ride: back or neck problems, heart conditions, pregnant women, recent surgery, illness or injury.
- Riders must wait for the ride to clear and the lifeguard's start signal before starting the ride.
- At the end of the slide, obey all signs and lifeguard instructions, and exit quickly.
- Keep arms and hands inside the flumes at all times.
- Loose items (such as cameras, wallets, hats, keys, sunglasses, etc.) should be left with a non-rider or secured. DryTown is not responsible for items lost on this ride.
- Casts, walking boots, devices with hard surfaces protecting injuries, and footwear of any kind are not permitted on the slides.
- Guests must ride one at a time, feet first only. Forming human "chains" is prohibited.
- No climbing on pipes or handrails. No hanging or swinging on ropes.
- Swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal are not permitted.
- Diapered guests must wear reusable plastic diaper covers.
- Maximum water depth is 1 ft. (.31 m)
- California Certificate of Compliance may be viewed at DryTown's Town Hall.
